Instructions for the Submission of Abstracts to the 3rd Annual Biofortification Meeting in Brazil

General Information

The ABSTRACT of the unpublished work should be typed in Word for Windows, Times New Roman 10, line spacing 1.5, A4 paper format, justified alignment with margins of 1.5 cm. It should not have more than 300 words.

The sender of the abstract will be responsible for its contents and compliance with the present instructions and for the co-authors as co-responsible for the scientific contents of the work.

The file containing the abstract should be named with the first author's complete name and saved as a Word document.

Structure and Organization

Title: Times New Roman 12, bold, capitals, centered.

Authors: first name (complete), middle names (initials) and last name (complete) in font 10; names should refer to the institutional address (font 9). The e-mail address of the corresponding author should follows. Underline the name of the author who will present the work.

Indexing Terms: maximum of 5 keywords (words used in the title should be avoided).

Abstracts should be submitted using the submission page (www.cpatc.embrapa.br/biofortbrasil). Submission closes in April 30. General Instructions for Poster Elaboration and Presentation

- 1) Sequence (suggestion): title, authors (including institutions and e-mails), introduction, material and methods, results and discussion, conclusions, references and, if it is the case, acknowledgments to the funding agency.
- 2) Space available for each poster: 0.90 m (width) X 1.50 m (length).

- 3) Location of poster and date presentation can be checked on the site of the event or when the final program is released.
- 4) The person responsible for presenting the poster should remain by it in June 3 and 4, from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- 5) The title of the poster should be identical to the title of the submitted abstract.
- 6) A place identified with the poster number will be reserved for each accepted abstract.
- 7) Authors should bring all the necessary material for setting up their posters.
